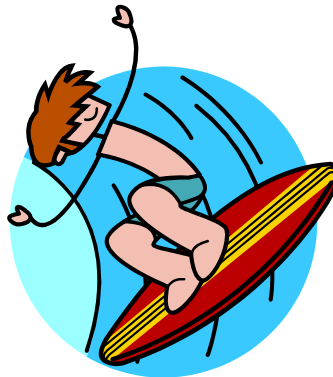

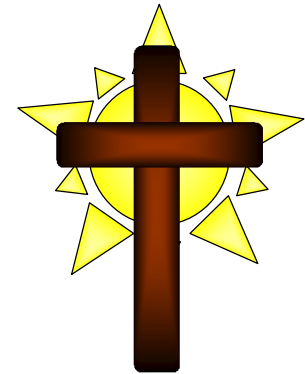


Parents are welcome to visit the program at anytime and have the right to view medical, discipline and background-check policies upon request made to the camp director.

Cost

Registration prior to June 1, 2011 is \$115 per week/\$110 family discount rate for all additional children in the same family attending the same week. FOR THE 2 FOUR DAY WEEKS (Week 1, July 5-8 and WEEK 5, AUGUST 1-4) REGISTRATION FEE IS \$100 PER WEEK. (No family discount for these two weeks.) ***Deposit of 50% total cost is due upon sign-up. TOTAL BALANCE (for all 7 weeks) is due by June 1st.***

Late Registration after June 1, 2011 is \$125 per week/\$120 family discount rate for all additional children attending the same week. ***TOTAL BALANCE due upon sign-up.***
